She can prescribe the contraceptive pill, fit an Implant and do STI tests.

Condoms are free to young people under the age of 25 with a 'Get it on' card.

They are available from anywhere that has this sign.....





What is it?

Condom Awareness

Each session will comprise of groups of either all male or all female pupils and it normally lasts around 45 minutes.

All sessions are held after-school.

Condom Awareness

During the session we will talk about relationships and contraception and will obviously look at and discuss condoms more closely.

You will even have the opportunity to put condoms on plastic willies!!

Consent

Consent is extremely important,
yet incredibly simple.

However, we cannot afford to get
it wrong!

Consent

Please do not ever assume that it is okay for you to hold hands, kiss or touch someone else if you haven't had their consent.

Sexual Harassment

What is Sexual Harassment?

Sexual harassment can be a one-off incident or an ongoing pattern of behaviour. It is unwanted behaviour of a sexual nature which:

- violates your dignity
- makes you feel intimidated, degraded or humiliated
- creates a hostile or offensive environment

It can include:

- flirting, gesturing or making sexual remarks about someone's body, clothing or appearance
- asking questions about someone's sex life
- telling sexually offensive jokes
- emailing, texting or messaging sexual content
- displaying pornographic or sexual images on posters, calendars and cards
- touching someone against their will

Consent

It is very important to remember that if someone is unable to give consent (they are under the influence of alcohol or drugs, asleep, passed out, etc), then they lack the capacity to be able to give consent.
