#### Listening

The receiving, retaining and processing of information or ideas

This skill is all about being able to effectively receive information: whether it comes from a pay, a seacher, or someone else entirely limitally, the skill steps concentrate un being able to listen effectively to others.

#### **Problem Solving**

The ability to find a solution to a situation or challenge

This skill focuses on how to solve problems, recognising that white part of Problem Solving is technical know-how and reperience, there are also transferable tupts that individuals can tevelop and use.

#### Staying Positive

The ability to use tactics and strategies to overcome setbacks and achieve goals

his skill is all about individuals being equipped to manage ner emotions effectively and being able to remain notivated, and altimately to motivate others, even when facing ethacts.

#### Leadership

Supporting, encouraging and develop others to achieve a shared goal

At the earliest stages, the focus is on basic empathy understanding their own feelings, being able to share them, and recognising the feelings of others. The focus is on managing dividing up tooks, managing time and sharing resources, managing group discussions and dealing with disagreements.

#### Speaking

The oral transmission information or ideas

This skill is all about how to communicate effectively with others, being mindful of whether they are talking to poers, teachers or others in different settings.

#### Creativitu

The use of imagination and he generation of new ideas

rativity is the complement to Problem Solving, and is about nerating innovations or ideas which can then be honed ough the problem-solving process.

#### **Aiming High**

The ability to set clear, tangible goals and devise a robust route to achieving them

This skill is about being able to plan effectively - both to arthieve unganisational goals, and also to set their own personal development targets, livinally, this is about knowing when something is too difficult, and having a sense of what doing well looks like for an individual.

#### Teamwork

Working cooperatively with others towar achieving a shared goal This skill appless to working within both formal

seams, and also with poers, teaching and others. Initially, this is about individuals fulfilling expectations around being positive, behaving appropriately, being timely, and reliable and taking responsibility.
